I will be in camp doing activities from 10:00am to 3:00pm. I may be signed up for Before Camp or After Camp, which means I get to stay longer at HMNS!



When I'm in camp, I will visit the exhibit halls and theaters, play and learn with friends, and participate in activities in the classroom and outside.

When it's lunchtime, we will eat in the classroom together while watching educational movies.

If something happens that upsets me, if I feel sick or sleepy, or if I have a question, I can always talk to the teachers, or someone in the Education Office.

At the end of the day, my guardian will pick me up from camp! I had a lot of fun learning new things at HMNS Summer Camp!
